



Craig Mackie Memorial Scholarship **- For UPEI Students -**

Description

The Immigrant & Refugee Services Association PEI (IRSA) has established the *Craig Mackie Memorial Scholarship* to assist first-generation immigrants to Canada who are in good academic standing at University of Prince Edward Island (UPEI) and are contributing to the community.

One scholarship valued at \$1000 will be awarded per academic year.

Eligibility Criteria

Scholarship applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria to be considered for an award scholarship. Applicants must:

- Be current students at UPEI;
- Be first-generation immigrants to Canada;
- Complete the application form;
- Write a personal statement (maximum 1 page) addressing their experience as a newcomer to Canada, their past and present community involvement, and future plans; and
- Enclose their unofficial transcript within their application package.

Preference will be given to students who have not yet received this scholarship.

Selection Criteria and Procedures

The IRSA Scholarship Selection Committee will consider the applicants' previous and current academic record and their community involvement.

Applications are due by 1 December each year.
